The 2015 Better Energy Communities application The situation with the 2015 Better Energy Communities application is that the project was passed by the SEAI but did not receive funding. Throughout 2015 we were told that it would be funded and later in the year they said that if funding was not available in 2015 it would be funded early in 2016 from 2016 funding. We have now been informed us that they cannot fund 2015 "reserve list" projects from 2016 funding and that we will have to apply again under the 2016 Better Energy Community Grant applications.
