Q. May I receive Holy Communion twice in the same day, for instance if I attend two funerals?

A: I quote the Catechism: "The Church warmly recommends that the faithful receive Holy Communion each time they participate in the celebration of the Eucharist". (#1417) so, if you attend Mass twice, or even more often, in the same day, it is warmly recommended that you receive the Blessed Eucharist as a completion of your participation with the Lord. The law which restricted people from receiving no more than once a day came in when people were going from one altar to another for Communion without taking part in the full ceremony.
